This term our focus has been on replacing the mats in the building, kitchen, and toilet with strong vinyl, finishing the two classrooms we're currently building, improving teacher salaries, and buying more chairs and cleaning materials.

We're almost done with the vinyl flooring and the two classrooms, though neither is fully finished yet. Once they're complete, we'll finally have the extra space we need — getting them usable has been our main challenge this term. Still ahead of us is the roof, kitchen cupboards for storage, running water connected to a proper drainage system, a hand wash basin in the toilet, a proper nappy changing station, and covering the remaining floors in the kitchen and toilet.

On the parent and community side, we run a fundraiser every second month and hold parent meetings once a term, with a WhatsApp group for daily communication. In April we sold curry vetkoek at R15 each and used the money to pay our builder, who is the grandfather of one of our children.

Our highlight this term was watching the children thrive — almost every child now has a chair to sit on, Morning Ring is full of energy, laughter, and joy, and most of them now know their Fonix sounds.

Next term, our plan is to finish the two classrooms completely and meet the health inspectors' requirements so we can get our food preparation certificate.
