34 children enrolled

This term our main focus has been adding a new classroom so that the children have more space. We've purchased some roof sheets for the extension project, though we still need to buy more before we can move ahead. We also built a new fence, because our children deserve a safe environment.



The storms set us back a bit — one of our classrooms suffered damage from the heavy rains, and we now need to repair the ceiling and floors. Our playground is also too small for the number of children we have.

There's been real good news: we received a donation of learning materials, including new puzzles, story books, and counting blocks, and the Adopt a Centre for Excellence funding allowed us to increase teacher salaries and improve staff wellbeing.

On the parent side, we held a quarterly parent meeting where we spoke about the importance of sending children to daycare, encouraging parents not to keep them at home, since children learn best when they're at school with friends and teachers. We keep in touch day-to-day through a WhatsApp group.

Looking ahead to next term, our plan is to build another toilet — right now we only have one, which causes long waiting periods, and a second one will improve hygiene and cut down on waiting time.
